family of agencies meets basic needs, advances economic security, pursues housing solutions, strengthens families and children, delivers compassionate mental health and addiction care, supports individuals with intellectual and developmental disabilities, welcomes immigrants and refugees, and more.

Karen brings a unique understanding of Catholic Charities’ mission, having served in positions of leadership for Catholic Charities of the Diocese of Albany and the Archdiocese of New York, and in consulting roles with other Catholic Charities agencies.

Building Our Workforce

927 employees provided direct services to nearly 25,000 people across 12 counties in 2022.



■ CCFCS increased the base wage for all frontline residential staff to \$17.25 an hour.



■ 441 CCFCS employees received NYS Longevity and Retention Bonuses for their work throughout the pandemic.

Across our agency, employees are offering testimonials that illustrate the fulfillment of the 2022 merger between Catholic Charities Community Services and Catholic Family Center: building on both agencies' strong foundations.

Building Stronger Families

For the past 3 years, CCFCS has provided over \$10,000,000 to households that had fallen behind on rental payments, including \$1,770,000 in 2022.

■ Our Community Residences served over 246 adults, supporting them as they reintegrate with family and community. 81% graduated to the next level of care.

■ 98% of families working with preventive services staff in our Children Youth and Family Services program were able to keep their children at home.



In 2022, our Community Resource Services (CRS) department helped 450 individuals in Monroe County stay in their homes, provided 94 families with one-time emergency needs, and 50 additional families with access to more nutritious food.

CRS has transitioned back from pandemic emergency assistance to its original role as a community center for addressing basic household needs. Many families remain in a fragile economic state due to food and housing instability. CCFCS has been and is prepared to help.



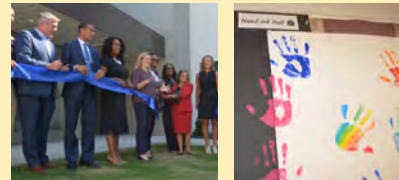
More than 1,100 older adults received services from our Expanded In-Home Services for the Elderly Program (EISEP) and Support to Aging Residents (STAR).

■ Kinship Navigator serves the needs of grandparents and other relatives and family friends who are caring for children full time. Almost 2100 individuals in 62 counties across NYS were supported in this program.



CCFCS expanded treatment services for women in recovery and their children:

Barrington House is the first treatment home in Monroe County to allow mothers to stay with their children during substance use recovery, providing accommodations for 23 women and 5 children.

In Newark, Hannick Hall reopened after a \$5,700,000 renovation designed to increase capacity for 30 women and 8 children. It is the only program of its kind in Wayne County.

Project Anchor

Monroe County awarded CCFCS \$2,500,000 to run a monthly rental supplement program, designed to help low-income families whose rent exceeds more than 30% of their monthly income.

ESL Food Insecurity Project

With a \$398,000, 2-year grant from the ESL Charitable Foundation, CRS will offer food security case management and education to CCFCS clients. The program coincides with the reopening of our food pantry for the first time since early 2020.



Building a Home for Refugees

CCFCS delivered direct resettlement services to more than 2,600 refugees in 2022.

Ukrainian War Crisis Response

In 2022, CCFCS responded to the Ukraine War Crisis and became one of the largest hubs for Ukrainian assistance in the country. From February to December, we served 531 Ukrainians who fled the war, to seek haven with friends and relatives in the Rochester area.

Yuliia K., her husband and young son fled Ukraine amid air alerts the day the war began, and she had this to say:

“It’s terrible when people have to leave their home suddenly. I looked into my son’s scared eyes, embraced him, and said, “I will be always near you...Mum would never leave you.” When we left Ukraine and came to the United States, of course, I was crying, because my previous life was broken. When we came to Rochester, our friend told us about Catholic Charities Family and Community Services. In a new country, everything is different, but with Catholic Charities, day by day I started to feel more comfortable here. My dream was to help



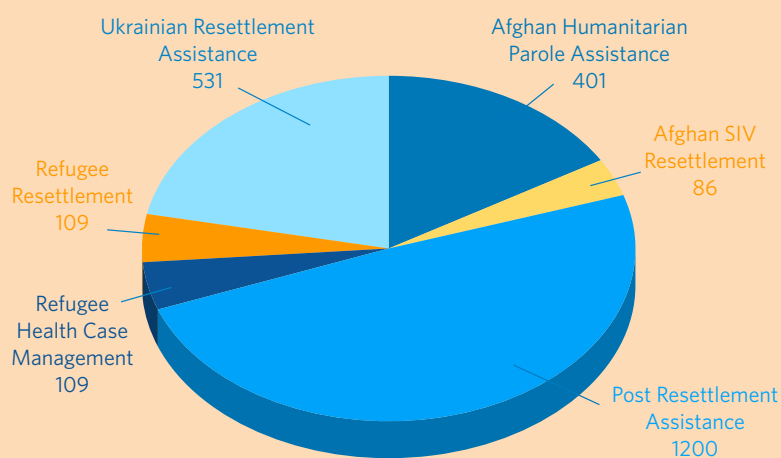
people the same way people helped me. I was hired as a case manager working in Refugee Resettlement at CCFCS, and now I am part of a great team whose mission is to support all who need us.”

Afghan Advocacy

With assistance from community partners and our own volunteers, CCFCS organized an immigration assistance effort to help more than 400 Afghan humanitarian parolees apply for asylum. CCFCS continues to advocate for permanent residency status for those Afghan families who are building new lives in Rochester after fleeing during the U.S. withdrawal from Afghanistan in August 2021.



Total number of refugees served in 2022:



- Our Refugee Employment Services program provided 200 individuals with job training and helped place 76 refugees in local jobs, thanks to our partners at Caldwell Manufacturing, Strong Staffing, Qualitrol, Advance Glass Industries, and Nu Way Auto Parts.
- In 2022, the Unaccompanied Refugee Minor Foster Care Program placed 37 teens from around the world in foster homes throughout Monroe County.
- Our Language Services Department provided 6,000 hours of interpreting services in 15 languages, including Amharic, Arabic, Cambodian, French, Russian, Somali, Spanish, and Ukrainian.

Building Community

In 2022, volunteers donated over 6,784 hours to CCFCS.



■ CCFCS entered a partnership with Rochester Cornerstone Group on new housing for seniors at the Marketplace Mall in Henrietta. CCFCS will provide supportive services to 34 tenants.

YouthBuild received \$2,400,000 from the City of Rochester under the American Rescue Plan Act. In 2022, 65 young people graduated from YouthBuild with the skills they need to enter the construction trades.



■ 1,836 individuals were served in shelters and supportive housing programs. A majority moved to permanent housing.

■ 77 individuals with intellectual and developmental disabilities live in 12 residential homes across three counties.

■ CCFCS is one of 10 local non-profit and government agencies teaming up with the City of Rochester for a pilot program to connect individuals on the streets to resources for food, clothing, shelter and healthcare.

■ 304 individuals with I/DD received Self-Directed Services.

Our Supportive Services Division is providing vocational services to more clients than ever. CCFCS expanded these services across the Finger Lakes region to help more than 200 people with disabilities and significant health challenges achieve their job goals.



Thanks to our donors, our Share the Joy holiday gift program had a record-breaking year, providing gifts for more than 2,400 clients.

Building Health and Wellness

For her role improving the health of the community during the pandemic, our CEO Lori VanAuken was named to the Power 30 Health Care List by the Rochester Business Journal.

■ 2,400 clients were served by the Outpatient Behavioral Health Clinic



■ 397 clients were served by the Integrated Care Program, almost double from that of 2021. Integrated Care allows clients to receive outpatient mental health and substance use treatment from one provider at the same location.



■ We served over 300 adults in our Intensive Residential treatment homes, which focus on stabilization and rehabilitation from substance use disorder.



CCFCS is now a designated provider of Community Oriented and Recovery Empowerment (CORE) services, making it easier for individuals with serious mental illness and substance use disorder to receive clinical services in their own home or community.

“I didn’t think I deserved to be healthy. I should be dead, but you just wouldn’t stop. You kept advocating for me. You helped me more than you could ever know.”

Over 742 adults and children are enrolled in our Care Coordination Programs, including 575 in Health Home Care Management.



■ 95% of our clients with HIV/AIDS have viral loads that are undetectable and 90% are compliant with HIV testing.

■ CCFCS offers on-site mental health services to students at three charter schools in the city of Rochester.
