At the heart of everything we do at Catholic Charities Family and Community Services (CCFCS) is a deep and abiding commitment to the people we serve in the villages, towns and cities where we live and work. Year after year, this enduring mission is reflected in the stories of our clients, our staff, and you, our generous supporters.



Indeed, in 2023 this mission allowed us to achieve several milestones. Here are just a few of them:

- With the backing of the NYS Office of Addiction and Substance Abuse Supports (OASAS), CCFCS developed a cutting edge, integrated health care program for individuals with a triple diagnosis of intellectual and developmental disability, substance use disorder, and mental illness. Called Tri-D, it is the only program of its kind in New York State and one of just a handful of such programs in the United States.
- To ensure they have the help they need to successfully age in place, CCFCS developed on-site supportive services for residents of the new Marketplace Senior Apartments in Henrietta.
- CCFCS was the only agency in the Finger Lakes region to be awarded a New York State grant to provide housing services and emergency financial assistance for people living with HIV/AIDS.

You can read about more milestones in this annual report.

Our mission is to walk alongside all who turn to us for care – over 21,000 clients from Lake Ontario to the Pennsylvania border. Our impact is told through their stories and the programs and partnerships that move us forward in service to the community. We cannot do this work without you, and we are most grateful.

## 2023 IMPACT 🦑 OUR PROGRAMS



"I love Catholic Charities Family and Community Services for helping me. I just kept imagining myself and my four young children being homeless and I was frightened that I wouldn't have any alternatives."

In 2023, Diana Chavez and her children were facing an uncertain future when their landlord moved to evict them from their home. Already traumatized by poverty and domestic violence, Diana was terrified she would lose her children to homelessness. In a referral from Child and Family Services of Monroe County, she turned to CCFCS for help.

Case managers from our Project Anchor program immediately began working with Diana to find new housing. Project Anchor took shape after the pandemic to address the ongoing crisis in affordable

housing across New York State. It's designed to help low-income families whose rent exceeds more than 30% of their income. Within months of being launched at CCFCS, more than 100 families were enrolled in Project Anchor – families like Diana and her children, who are desperately fighting to maintain a stable home.

Demand for housing assistance is at an all-time high. Today, Project Anchor is helping 183 families with rental subsidies, and expects to help hundreds more in the months to come. Diana is now living in a new home in a safer neighborhood, and her children are thriving at school. For the first time in years, she is hopeful and confident about the future.

# "I tell them, 'I know how you feel,' because I really do."

At CCFCS, it's not unusual to meet staff who have walked the same path as their clients. Obaida Omar's personal and professional journey makes her uniquely qualified for her role as Manager of Preferred Communities, a Health Case Management program for newly arrived refugees. Obaida is a former refugee who fled the violence and turmoil in Afghanistan during the Soviet invasion of the 1980s. After resettling in the U.S., she went on to marry, make a career in social work, and raise a family. She cherishes her role as mother to three children: her daughter and son, both pharmacists, and her youngest son, who has a developmental disability. Obaida uses this lived experience to help others, targeting her work to refugee families who are experiencing acute or chronic medical and mental health conditions or who need urgent care.

For her efforts, Obaida was named a 2023 Health Care Hero by the Rochester Business Journal. It's a tribute that sheds light on the program she champions. The Preferred Communities program is a lifeline for our refugee clients who grapple with traumatic experiences, language barriers, and the intricacies of the healthcare system. Obaida and her team offer crucial assistance as these families navigate their journey toward healing, well-being, and new life in the U.S.

"I learned so much about myself in YouthBuild. I became more patient and generous with others, especially my classmates. I learned how to do something I never thought I'd do. A job is easy to get, but YouthBuild gave me a career."

Alvin Metcalf III grew up in Rochester, attended high school in Florida, then moved back with no car, no job, and few prospects. He was struggling to find direction in life when friends and family steered him toward YouthBuild, the national career and technical program run in Rochester by Catholic Charities Family and Community Services.

YouthBuild offers youth ages 18 to 24 hands-on construction training and job placement. But it's more than a vocational program. CCFCS staff serve as vital

mentors, helping young people obtain driver's licenses, complete high school educations, secure mental health counseling, and more. In addition, thanks to our partnership with Flower City Habitat for Humanity, students get valuable on-site training, helping build and rehabilitate affordable housing in Rochester. In 2023, YouthBuild was awarded \$2.4 million from the City of Rochester under the American Rescue Plan Act, allowing it to move to a new and larger training site. The site is conveniently located on a bus line and offers both classroom and workshop space for students.

Since 2018, 160 young people have graduated from YouthBuild with certification in the construction trades. Alvin is one of them. Soon after he completed the program, he was hired by Habitat for Humanity as a Construction Team Leader. He calls it one of the happiest moments of his life.



"I wake up every day knowing I'm building my career, and I don't have to depend on anybody else. That's what YouthBuild gave me. I still wear my YouthBuild hat every day. It's my pride and joy!"

Over the past 20 years, Empty Bowls has evolved into a cherished fundraising tradition at Catholic Charities Family and Community Services. No one has had more of a hand in its success than Terry Klee.

Klee is the long-time owner of Don's Original, an iconic Rochester restaurant. After joining the board of directors for Catholic Family Center in 2004, Klee quickly realized he could be of service promoting and sponsoring Empty Bowls, the grassroots soup dinner fundraiser designed to raise awareness about hunger and homelessness. Klee provided Empty Bowls with food from his own restaurant, solicited other food and beverage vendors to take part, and brought his own kitchen staff to work the event. Every year since, Empty Bowls has jumped in revenue and attendance.

In 2023, nearly 500 people turned out for Empty Bowls and donated more than \$50,000 – both record numbers. Klee and his team were there as always, serving with generosity and good cheer. We are forever indebted to him for his leadership and support.
