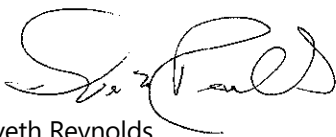
We have so many more reasons to be thankful as we enter another year of service to our neighbors, friends, and families in need.

- Due to unprecedented changes from the federal government, we have had to close our Refugee Resettlement Program. However, in keeping with our mission, CCFCS remains committed to welcoming New Americans. In 2024, we resettled 1,200 newly arrived refugees. We served thousands more through a variety of programs to help refugees and immigrants achieve stability and self-sufficiency. You can read more about our exceptional Refugee Employment Services program in this annual report.
- CCFCS launched a new program called Permanency Resource Centers, serving adoptive parents, grandparents, legal guardians, and kin caregivers in Monroe, Schuyler, Steuben, and Wayne Counties.
- We provided 27,596 sessions for children and adults seeking mental health and/or substance use treatment at our Outpatient Behavioral Health Clinic in Rochester.
- Through the new Emergency Rental Assistance Program (ERAP), we began working with LawNY to help eligible individuals avoid eviction, helping to stabilize housing for hundreds of people.

A LETTER FROM The Most Reverend Salvatore R. Matano

My dear sisters and brothers in Christ:

In his letter announcing the 9th World Day of the Poor during this Jubilee Year of Hope, our new Holy Father, Pope Leo XIV, wrote eloquently about the Church's mission and responsibility to those in need:



"The gravest form of poverty is not to know God. As Pope Francis wrote in *Evangelii Gaudium*: 'The worst discrimination which the poor suffer is the lack of spiritual care. The great majority of the poor have a special openness to the faith; they need God and we must not fail to offer them his friendship, his blessing, his word, the celebration of the sacraments and a journey of growth and maturity in the faith' (No. 2000).... The poor are not a distraction for the Church, but our beloved brothers and sisters, for by their lives, their words and their wisdom, they put us in contact with the truth of the Gospel."

As we reflect upon the work of Catholic Charities Family and Community Services (CCFCS), especially the stories and statistics contained within this Annual Report, we realize they are about more than mere numbers – they describe encounters with real persons, made in the image and likeness of God. These, our sisters and brothers, encounter Him whenever we put our Catholic faith in action, allowing the light of Jesus Christ to shine brightly in our communities. In 2024, over 21,000 individuals and families throughout our twelve counties were served with compassion, advocacy, and support through the programs of CCFCS. Whether assisting a family in crisis, welcoming a refugee, sheltering the homeless, or offering pathways to stability, Catholic Charities continues to be a beacon of Christ's mercy and love.

Each year, this Annual Report serves as a reminder to all of us, the dedicated staff and volunteers, as well as our generous donors and partners in mission, that we have the sacred obligation to bring the Gospel to those whom we serve. "By recognizing that God is our first and only hope, we too pass from fleeting hopes to a lasting hope. Once we desire that God accompany us on the journey of life, material wealth becomes relativized, for we discover the real treasure that we need." (Pope Leo XIV, Message for the 9th World Day of the Poor).

To all of you, I extend my heartfelt gratitude for your generosity and fidelity to this mission of the Church. Your prayers, gifts, and service embody the commandment to love and uphold the dignity of every person as a beloved child of God.

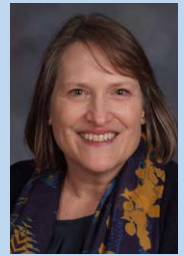

Refugee Employment Services

When Moses B. arrived in Rochester from Liberia in 2024, he wondered how he would provide for his wife and children. Today, he's one of 30 refugees employed by Jamestown Container in Rochester. Over the past several years, the packaging manufacturer has come to appreciate CCFCS as a reliable partner in building a skilled, highly motivated workforce. And it's not the only local employer who thinks so. More than 100 Rochester businesses, schools, health care organizations and non-profits employ refugees who started their journey to economic self-sufficiency in the Refugee Employment Services Program (RES) at CCFCS.

RES serves up to 500 refugees every year and has placed more than 370 refugees in local jobs since 2019. Over the same period, more than half of the refugees placed in jobs by RES became self-sufficient within 90 days of employment. That remarkable achievement is just one reason RES was awarded a record-setting, \$5.4 million job preparation and placement grant from the NYS Office of Temporary and Disability Assistance, Bureau of Refugee Services. The 5-year grant is already being used to ramp up

job readiness programs and partnerships, including English language lessons, transportation support, and outreach to employers.

Lameisha Mack supervises a diverse team of 13, including former refugees. Together, they assist refugees who've been in the U.S. 5 years or less, providing services that include employment assessment, resume preparation, job search and completion of job applications, accompanying clients to interviews and orientations, and follow-up to ensure retention.

It's not unusual for former refugees to visit RES to share their successes: obtaining driver's licenses, mastering on-the-job safety courses, securing promotions. Some build on their early success to start small businesses of their own.

Moses B. says Jamestown Container has been very welcoming and friendly. His job is a source of pride as his family settles into new routines at home, at school, and in the community. "It's the beginning of many good things for me and my family," he says. "I appreciate everything."

Seana Denning's advocacy for her clients isn't just a job, it's a calling. Seana's 23-year tenure at CCFCS is marked by her compassion, problem-solving, and leadership. Seana is one of the program directors for the CCFCS Health Homes Programs, which serve children and adults with chronic health challenges. The goal of the program is to help clients stay healthy and out of the hospital or emergency room, by addressing barriers to care, including mental health and trauma.

For Seana, it's vital work. She is known for dropping everything to help a client – including a 9-year-old girl whose father had died and whose mother was unable to care for her. When she went to live with her grandmother, she was referred to the Health Homes program by a school social worker. Over the next several years, Seana worked to connect her to mental health services and other community resources. This support proved crucial when the girl's grandmother died. She moved back in with her mother, who at that point was not only dealing with substance use disorder, but a very serious illness. When the girl found her mother unconscious, Seana was the first person she called, and Seana remained by her side weeks later at her mother's funeral. Today, this girl is a junior in high school and determined to graduate. When that happens, Seana will be seated in the front row to cheer her on.

Co-workers, community partners, and clients all agree: Seana forges relationships built on trust and a mutual desire to succeed, always leading with honesty, transparency, joy, and a belief in the dignity of all.



Mark F.

When Mark F. spins tunes for an audience, he's fulfilling one of his biggest wishes – to build a career as a disc jockey. He has plenty of support to help make his dreams come true. Mark is a 22-year-old in the CCFCFS Self-Directed Services Program for individuals with Intellectual and Developmental Disabilities. He meets every week with his Direct Support Professional, John Lyon. John helps Mark achieve his goals at home and in the community. When Mark wanted to learn how to cook, John didn't just take him to cooking lessons, he taught him how to google recipes and accompanied him to the grocery store to teach him how to shop for the ingredients in his favorite dishes. When Mark decided he wanted to DJ, he joined Bach to Rock music school.

John takes him to weekly DJ lessons and DJ gigs in the community. Everything Mark and John do is designed to help Mark live a life of autonomy, based on his own choices.

In the two years Mark has been enrolled in Self-Direction, the change has been profound. Where he used to be reserved, Mark engages in conversation. He is learning new skills every day. He's more confident and more curious about the world around him. Mark's parents say if Mark is safe and happy, they are at peace.

Under the Self-Directed Services program at CCFCFS, people hire, schedule and supervise the staff who support them. In fact, Mark interviewed John for the job.

Today, Mark works Monday through Friday at Arc Deli, a division of the Arc of Monroe. With John's help, he took driving lessons. He's acquired memberships to the zoo, local museums, and the YMCA. He's cooking plenty of dishes, including pizza and eggs. And he's playing music at local events. Mark calls himself "DJ Chef" because he's living the life he chooses, by his own design.

The Community Resource Services program (CRS) at CCFCs receives well over 100 calls per week from individuals who are facing extremely difficult challenges. Mike Lutz is often their first point of contact, and he takes his role to heart.

As an Intake Volunteer, Lutz helps get information to people who reach out for financial assistance, pending eviction or food insecurity. Not only does he provide each caller with the information they need to follow up on resources, he also documents their situation so that staff can respond personally and quickly to each caller.

Lutz graduated from St. John Fisher University and graduate school at the University of Buffalo. He then spent 40 years as a professor of computer science and software engineering at RIT. When he retired, he wanted to stay connected to the community. At the time, he was inspired by the love of his wife and three grown children and the wisdom of his parents and teachers, who emphasized the importance of helping others.

Volunteering at CRS allows Lutz to use his skills as a teacher, but in meaningful new ways. Mike provides crucial information to people in crisis. They call because they need food, rental assistance, or clothes. If he can guide even one person to a better outcome, he is grateful.
