\$75,000 will increase our capacity to provide a tuition reimbursement program that will help CFC staff to further their job-related educational goals and advance in their careers.

\$25,000 will fund legal support for kinship care providers who need to go to family court, keeping families together and avoiding the higher costs of foster care.

\$15,000 will sustain a home repair program for low income seniors struggling to maintain their homes, enabling their independence and safety.

\$5,000 will sponsor one young man through 6-months in our Day Drug Rehabilitation, providing life skills and support to those struggling with a chronic chemical dependency. Success through this program can reduce future arrests for 98% of individuals battling addiction.
